Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes

Held July 15, 2026

The Selover Public Library Board of Trustees met at the library on Wednesday, July 15, 2026 for their regular monthly meeting. In attendance were Charlotte Chipps, Jon Jensen, Jeff Jordan, Ronda Siegfried, Kristin Weaver and Director Martha Wall.

President Jon Jensen called the meeting to order at 6:07 P.M. and welcomed everyone.

The agenda was read and approved.

The minutes of the June 17, 2026 board meeting were read and an error was found that prevented the minutes from being approved. The error was noted and a revised version will be provided at the next meeting for review and approval.

The Treasurer's Report for June 2026 was shared by Fiscal Officer Jeff Jordan. It was accepted and a copy may be seen in the fiscal officer's file.

OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business to report.

NEW BUSINESS: Director Wall reported that the library has been awarded the ALA Grant to help children with disabilities. The grant amount is \$10,000 and will be used to purchase materials, furniture, and cover staffing costs associated with training for the materials purchased. She requested initial appropriations for materials to be \$5,000 and staffing to be \$1,000.

26-11 – Kristin Weaver made a motion to approve the appropriations for the ALA Grant as seen in the chart below. Jon Jensen seconded the motion. Motion passed with Chipps – aye, Jensen – aye, Jordan – aye, Siegfried – aye, Weaver – aye.

This is part of the Guiding Ohio Online Grant that was awarded to Mount Gilead Public Library. He has a survey available for patrons to choose areas that they would like his help with. An appointment calendar is being set up to allow patrons to schedule a specific meeting time.

Director Wall informed the board that Mark Tingley has resigned. He has offered to continue volunteering with the Chess Program in the fall.

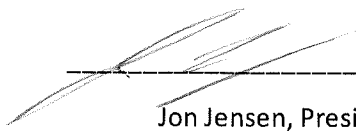
Director Wall shared the library statistics for June 2026.

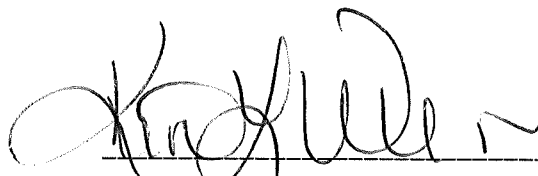
Director Wall shared that the park signs have been ordered but they will not be ready before the celebration on July 18th.
