

Held May 1820 22

The May 18th, 2022 regular monthly meeting of the Selover Public Library Board of Trustees was held at the library at 6:00 P. M. Attending the meeting were trustees Charlotte Chipps, Linda Goare, Jeff Jordan, Joyce Ray, Ronda Siegfried and Kristin Weaver. Director Martha Wall was in attendance as well as guest Annie Frazier.

President Joyce Ray called the meeting to order.

Annie Frazier from Perry-Cook Memorial Library was welcomed.

The agenda was approved with one addition.

The minutes of the April 20th, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

The clerk/treasurer's report was presented by Fiscal Officer Jeff Jordan and accepted. A copy may be seen in the clerk's file. It was reported a Bureau of Worker's Compensation audit will be conducted on June 21st, 2022 at 9:00 A. M. at the library.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion was held concerning posting of the dates of board meetings on the library website calendar.

22-7 Charlotte Chipps made a motion to post the dates of the board meetings on the library website calendar. Motion seconded by Ronda Siegfried. Motion passed with all trustees voting aye.

Updates to the summer reading program which begins on June 12th, 2022 were shared.

Director Wall attended an OLC workshop on May 5th, 2022. The focus of the workshop was library tax ballots.

Next Tuesday, May 24th, 2022 at 6:00 P. M. an online event will be conducted by the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency. Registration is required.

Selover will participate in a summer food service program sponsored by the Children's Hunger Alliance. Lunch will be provided on Thursday's and Friday's from 12:00 P. M. to 1:00 P. M. at the library.

Director Wall shared photo's and information about the following things happening lately at the library: Homeschool Book Club, Flower hunt, Chick incubator from the Extension Office, Preschool storytime, Drone racing nationals (Matthew Hebauf represented Selover), Gardening class, 3D printer class, Chesterville and Marengo plant swaps, Neighborhood Forest tree giveaway, Bingo for books, Chess club, Mulching by the 4H-IO 4-H Club, and the elementary art display in the foyer.
