The Board of Trustees of the Selover Public Library met on October 19th, 2022 for a regular monthly meeting. They gathered at the library at 6:00 P.M. President Joyce Ray called the meeting to order at 6:15 P.M.

The agenda was approved after one addition.

The minutes of the September 21st, 2022 meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report for September, 2022 was presented and accepted. A copy may be seen in the fiscal officer's file.

OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS: The possibility of having a staff and trustee Christmas party was discussed. A tentative date of December 4th, 2022 was decided upon and a possible location was agreed on. Final plans will be announced by the November meeting.

The date and time of the December regular meeting and the reorganizational meeting were changed to Tuesday, December 13th, 2022 at 5:00 P.M. They will be held at the library in the community room.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Library statistics for August, 2022 were shared along with statistics from the summer reading program.

Online self-registration for a library eCard is now available.

Selover Public Library is now collaborating with the Chesterville Arts Series to present programs at the Chester Town Hall. On Saturday, October 22nd, 2022 a Halloween themed program will be presented. In November, a program in honor of Veterans Day will be held.

The monthly newsletter for the library known as "Selover Scoop", is now available online.


